MASTER SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

1. Awards and Ribbons will be awarded to the Master Showman in each division.
2. First place winner in all showmanship divisions will compete for MASTER SHOWMAN.
3. Contestant will not show his or her own animals.
4. Contestants are required to wear the uniform of the organization they represent.
5. Minis to not compete.
6. Contestants will report to the show ring for check-in at 4:00 pm Friday, February 21.



MARKET GOAT

SPECIAL RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Market goats must show kid teeth.
2. After Weigh-in, market goats will be classified according to weight for judging purposes.
3. If animals grade for auction, maximum pay weight will be adjusted to 120 pounds.
4. No muzzles allowed.
5. Castration and DEHORNING (1 inch scur) is required.
6. U.S.D.A. CHEVON GRADES:
 - **MARKET READY:** USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08-.12 most desirable, .13-.22 back fat acceptable, average of greater conformation and cut ability.
 - **NOT MARKET READY:** Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 or >.22: under finished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cut ability.
