MARKET LAMBS

SPECIAL RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Market lambs must be slick-shorn before weigh-in.
2. Lambs must show lambs teeth.
3. After weigh-in, market lambs will be classified according to weight for judging purposes.
4. If animal grades for auction, maximum pay weight will be adjusted to 160 pounds.
5. U.S.D.A. Market Lamb Grades:
 - MARKET READY:** U.S.D.A. Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .16-.35, average or greater conformation and cut ability.
 - NOT MARKET READY:** U.S.D.A. Good or lower quality with 12th rib back fat range <.16-.35 >, below average conformation or cut ability.
