



Livestock Exhibitors:

The California Department of Food & Agriculture is requiring that all youth livestock exhibitors, showing at Fairs throughout California in 2020, must have completed the applicable Youth Quality Assurance (YQCA) program training.

In order to show at the Riverside County Fair & National Date Festival, every exhibitor is required to have completed an approved YQCA training program and have proof of YQCA certification. Certification is required for all exhibitors showing any of the following animals: beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goats, meat goats, sheep, swine, poultry, and/or rabbits.

A YQCA confirmation number will be assigned upon completion of the program courses. You are required to provide a certification with proof of completion, when requested, by any member of the Fair staff or any representative from California Department of Food & Agriculture.

The Riverside County Fair & National Date Festival is requiring that exhibitors enter their YQCA Certification Numbers online when registering their exhibits. There will be a YQCA NUMBER field listed within our ShoWorks online entry program. *The field is listed after the Exhibitor Name and Address.*
